## Disaster Relief Information

That was quite a week! First, we welcome back those who have been gone to graduations, weddings, Memorial Day weekend trips, and vacations. We missed you!

Secondly, we praise God that none of you were hurt by Tuesday's twister that ripped through the area. We continue to pray for those who are affected. I've received many questions from you as to what we can do as a church. At this point (and I had to write this on Thursday) there is nothing for us to do as a church. I contacted Baptist Disaster Relief in Kansas and Missouri, the Director of Missions in the Kansas City Kansas Baptist Association as well as the Flint Hills Baptist Association, the coordinator for Kansas Disaster Relief in Lenexa, the president of the Kansas Nebraska Convention of Southern Baptists, the Secretary of the Kansas Nebraska Convention of Southern Baptists, the police, the county commission, and two churches in the affected area. At this point, we are not needed as a church. You may know of individuals in the affected area who have specific needs and I encourage you to meet those needs. Reach out to others in the church who may be able to help.

It is still possible we will still be asked to help as a church. It may be as far as a month from now. If we are, we would likely be sent to designated area and asked to clean it up. We will certainly let you know. Thanks for the way you love people, West Haven. I love you!!
