## *A Weekly Note From* **Pastor Ryon Sander**

Good morning! I'm glad you are here this morning! You are a blessing and I am thankful for you. Each week I look forward to gathering together with our church in worship. I love our church!

I've been so encouraged by the heart of our church family to serve and reach people. I'm hearing more stories every day about One Life and loving those in our area. Weather-wise this year has been rough. The winter was daunting. Then spring brought forth flooding and a tornado that hit too close to home. It has made a significant impact on my "One Life" relationships and you may be experiencing this too. People retreated inside for months on end over the winter and when spring hit the rains kept our community home bound. When I finally started connecting again with my One Life I felt as though I was almost starting over. However, the tornado opened a lot of doors for ministry. We have not only had the chance to serve others in the name of Christ, it has opened the door for many conversations. I have been able to share where our church is engaged. I have been able to process with a few the reality that this life is fragile and there are no guarantees except Christ. People will still be talking about the devastation of that tornado for a while so try to leverage those conversations to draw attention to Christ. I usually say things like; "our church has been praying for those affected" or "We had a group of people that helped with some of the clean-up and were overwhelmed with the devastation". I try to avoid coming off as making our church out to be the hero, instead I try to lead the conversation to show as Christians we are empathetic when we see hurting people. Talking about loss is easily transitioned into talking about the bigger picture, eternity and the certainty of Christ.

I hope this encourages you as you engage the broken world around you. If you have one of these conversations with an unbeliever, I would love to hear about it!
