## *A Weekly Note From* **Pastor Mike Bronson**

**This morning at West Haven we are closing in on the end of the book of Luke.** We started the book because as the series title says “We Want to See Jesus.” Today we see God glorified by the death of His Son on the cross. Paul said, “The cross is foolishness to those who are perishing but to us who are being saved, it is the power of God.” If you are visiting, thanks for being here! We encourage you to investigate membership at West Haven by checking the “New Members Class” box on the back of your worship attendance information slip. Either myself or Pastor Ryon will set up a time to meet with you.

**When I end Luke, I will preach a few stand alone sermons.** On August 18, 25, and Sept. 1, we are going to use material from the Southern Baptist Convention entitled “Who’s Your One?” Then on Sept. 8, the day of our Community Carnival, we’ll have an outdoor service in the parking lot. You’ll be encouraged to bring your unchurched friends and neighbors. That will be an evangelistic service. And then we’ll set up for and have the carnival. Then Sept. 15 will be “Student Ministry Sunday.” Student Ministry leaders Bill Weatherford and Nathan LaFave will co-preach a sermon about the importance of students in the local church and their spiritual formation. After that, we’ll probably go onto a walk through Ecclesiastes to learn about “Wise Living.” Pray for us as we make plans for the upcoming days, that we would step into the main stream of all that God has for us.
