The Lord is blessing us as we move rapidly through this summer. We have a baptism today. We have plans for the upcoming months to stimulate you to love and good deeds, and to glorify our Lord.

On Aug. 25 and Sept. 1, I'll preach sermons around the theme "Who's Your One?" It's similar to "One Life." We'll have material to empower you to invite someone to church on Sept. 8. We'll have an outdoor evangelistic service that morning, in our parking lot. That afternoon is the Community Carnival.

On Sept. 15 we'll have "Student Ministry Sunday." Student Ministry leaders Bill Weatherford and Nathan LaFave will "co-preach" a sermon about the importance of family and church in raising children. The goal is emphasize the importance of student ministry and engender multigenerational fellowship.

The goal of all this is glorify Christ and grow you spiritually. I really, truly hope that **EVERY** one of you will take advantage of these opportunities. The time is short. The day is drawing near. What a joy it will be if we are fully prepared to meet our Master!
