**Please welcome David Manner to the West Haven pulpit this morning.** David is the Associate Executive Director of the Kansas Nebraska Convention of Southern Baptists. His convention responsibilities include leadership development, church health and worship consultation. Before joining the convention staff in 2000, he served for 20 years in worship and administration with churches in Kansas, Arkansas, Texas, and Oklahoma. He writes for various online and print publications.

**Our convention has the difficult task of trying to help churches to evangelize and disciple a vast amount of territory.** There are 198 counties and only 104 have a Southern Baptist presence. Many have no evangelical presence at all. There are 431 SBC churches and missions between the two states. There are 18 campus ministers. In 2018 1,919 baptisms were reported. Our convention is trying to do much with little. They partner often with non-SBC churches of like faith and practice. I appreciate their efforts and I'm excited for you to hear from David today.

## Childcare for the Spiritual Growth Conference

**We are partnering with Tonganoxie Christian Church to provide childcare for up to 50 children for the Spiritual Growth Conference on Nov. 1-2.** Childcare is offered from 12 months to 5<sup>th</sup> grade. They will have snacks on Friday, a meal plus two snacks on Saturday (If your child has allergies you must send snacks and meals for your child). The cost is \$20 for the first child, \$15 for the second, and \$10 for each additional child. There will be two unrelated adults in each classroom and have the same security requirements that we have for childcare. They are doing this as a fundraiser for their student ministry.
