Over the next two months we are praying for our ONE Life. You may have noticed umbrellas hanging up in our foyer. They are to help us remember to pray. There are small cards by the ONE Life poster in the foyer that you can use to write a prayer request for your ONE Life. Then toss the card in one of the umbrellas. As a church will pray for those requests at a couple of key times in April.

Invite Cards

Easter is the one time during a year that people are the most receptive to church invites. Starting next Sunday you will find a West Haven business card on your seat in the Worship Center. These cards are to be given out as an invitation to join you at church. When you give the card to someone don't just invite them to church invite them to attend with you. Tell them you will meet them at the door so they can sit with you in worship. You might also consider inviting them to the Easter breakfast at 8:30 a.m. These cards will be available for the next several months as a tool for outreach.

A Weekly Note From

PASTOR Mike Bronson

I'm glad to see you in the Lord's house this morning. You'll notice in your bulletin a prayer guide and offering envelope for the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering. All giving to this offering goes to the North American Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention. We partner with the over 47,000 churches in the convention to fund NAMB which plants churches in areas that have a comparatively low ratio of evangelical churches to population. They also operate the third largest relief organization in the world, behind the Red Cross and the Salvation Army. I want to show you a video about their Legacy Church planting movement, which I think may be the most valuable aspect of their work. We are blessed to be part of a convention that holds to the inerrancy of God's Word and takes action to combat lostness.

As you pray and seek to reach your "One Life" remember that Easter is April 1 (no fooling.) It is still the day that the lost are the most receptive to an invitation to church. If you have been looking for an opportunity, this might be your best one. We have confidence that when the lost hear the Word preached (regardless of the passage), the Spirit of God and the Word of God can generate saving faith. Romans tells us "faith comes by hearing" and "hearing by the Word of the Lord."

Romans 12:10 says to "outdo one another in showing honor." Who can you encourage this morning? I've heard it said "no one has ever been too encouraged." Who can you "out do" in "thinking of one another more important than yourselves (Phil 2:3)?" Let's build a culture of honoring and encouraging one another.
