Good morning West Haven family! I cannot express how much I look forward to gathering with you every Sunday. I deeply appreciate all of you and the prayers you have offered for our family. They have been truly a blessing.

I want to draw your attention to the business card laying on your seat this morning. It is a tool to invite people to join you for Church. I have read many different articles recently that encourage churches to invite people to Easter services. It is the one time during a year that people welcome the invitation and are the most receptive to attending church.

These are some suggestions you might consider when inviting someone to church. The most effective way to invite a person to church is to think of West Haven as if it were your own home and you are the host. Be sure to communicate the time, how our church dresses, what to bring (a Bible if they have one). Offer to pick them up or if they drive, watch for their car to enter the parking lot. Meet them at their car, if they have young kids help carry the extras. Walk through the doors with them. Make sure they get a bulletin or any helpful information from the visitor kiosk. If anyone from church begins talking with you be sure to first introduce your guests and include them in conversations. If your guests join you at the breakfast, be sure to sit across from them to make fellowship easier. Whether at the breakfast or in the worship center make sure they sit with you and offer them the better seats next to isle. If an extra chair is needed be the one to round up that chair. If they don't have plans invite them over for lunch after church. Let them see your excitement for our church family this Easter!
