HONDURAS WELL

Drillers struck water at 280 feet for the La Finca de Los Niños orphanage in Honduras. The orphanage now has portable water on site.

Alonzo Gómez (the head of orphanage) oversaw the work, is paying the contractors, etc. Below is a statement from Rhonda Covington of Foundation Missions, Inc.

"The children will never have to have dirty clothes and be able to bathe because of a lack of water. More importantly, they will never be thirsty again because the water is gone! Now, they will always have water! Praise the Lord! I am so grateful that you guys decided to take on this project. It will last for many years to come. That well will serve thousands of children in the future!"
