A Weekly Note From

PASTOR Ryon Sander

Good morning West Haven family. I have been encouraged by the number of you investing in ONE Life. You are not normal! I mean that in a good way. West Haven is not normal. Why? Because we have made a shift to love and reach our community. The normal approach is to ignore carrying out the great commission as individuals or to force all evangelism efforts into a program or event.

In our nation there are some efforts being made to make the shift to loving and reaching communities but they are mostly being done through church planting. Some see it easier to start a new church with a focus on outreach than to shift the direction of an already established church. West Haven has made the shift to outreach and we are not normal. Another established church in Longmont Colorado made the shift to outreach and from that came the book "The Neighboring Church" by Rick Rusaw and Brian Mavis. It almost mirrors the groundwork for outreach that was laid here at West Haven. It is my recommended reading for May & June and I highly encourage you to read it.

The shift this year at West Haven has been to invest in ONE person that God has placed in your path. ONE person that you see often. ONE person that doesn't know Jesus. If you are just now ready to invest in ONE Life go to our website and download the first PDF (Jan & Feb). There is no wrong time to begin investing in a lost person. You may be making leaps and bounds or you may be starting the search looking for a new ONE Life. When we love people and carry out the great commission we fulfill our part as a Christian. We however are not guaranteed how our ONE Life will respond. We are moving into the relational involvement portion of ONE Life and all of us will have different responses and experiences. I encourage you to not give up, be patient, be loving, make an effort, share your life and most of all share Jesus. How are you going to share your time with your ONE Life?
