A Weekly Note From **PASTOR Ryon Sander**

Good morning West Haven Family! I'm excited to preach the Word of God this morning! Please take a moment and pray for our Worship Service this morning and for the salvation of our community.

We are now moving into month two of the discipleship segment of ONE Life. August is upon us and I cannot believe how fast this year is passing. We are over half-way through our first year in ONE Life. How are you doing with your ONE Life relationship? I would love to hear about it. I have been trying to share Christ for some time now with one of my ONE Life's. He is open to the discussion and he has even initiated the conversation several times. However, every time we start to talk about the gospel there is an interruption. I'm not talking about little distractions. I'm talking “the neighbors lit a car on fire and are dancing around it with kazoos” type disruptions. Disruptions that kill good conversation. They are no fault of his or mine, but I realize if I want to move into a time of deeper conversation and study I am going to need to schedule a time and set the location away from potential interruptions.

A great discipling relationship is intentional and consistent.

Set a time when you can meet one or more times a month. Once a week would be ideal but be realistic with expectations. Meet somewhere that encourages relationship. Great conversations happen when the atmosphere is easy and relaxed. A boat, a picnic table, Panera Bread, your home, and so on. Try to avoid places that have a lot of interruptions like the local coffee hangout where everyone knows everyone and you are highly visible, places where the atmosphere is loud (background music, other conversations, traffic, etc.). If possible set a time when you can visit longer if the conversation is going well. Trying to cram a gospel conversation into a 10 minute segment between breakfast and work may not go so well. I am hearing stories and seeing results that many of you are indeed investing in ONE Life. It is making a difference. Thank you for your faithfulness! I want to encourage you to keep striving to live like Christ in a lost world!
